Rev. Faith C. Tolson was born in Providence Rhode Island, raised in Roxbury, moved to Natick, MA with her family at the age of thirteen, and has lived in Framingham, MA for over 30 years.

Rev. Faith's initial religious experience was at the age of eight, at St. Cyprian's church where she attended Sunday School, and a seed was planted.
